

Canary Divers Trips

For the editor of the newsletter (that's me!) the highlight of the diving trips this year was a weekend camping and diving in Cornwall. Having heard so much about the sinking of the HMS Scylla to create a natural reef this dive site just had to be a high priority this year. The site itself is accessible by boat and is buoyed at both bow and stern. Dropping down either line reveals the structure of this Leander Class Frigate from Devonport.

She lies in 20m of water in Whitsand Bay off the south of Cornwall and is an amazing insight into life on a frigate. Both decks can be explored and the careful planning by the owners means that divers are generally never more than a few seconds from a hold in the structure to exit the vessel. Warning signs are hung around the ship where it is unsafe to go.



Whether you fancy yourself as the captain of the boat and want to stand on the bridge or just want to explore, this has to be one of the best artificial reefs around.

During the weekend we also dived a number of reefs as well as the James Eagan Layne.
